## Peace Garden

The Pat Merriman Peace Garden, opened in June 2022, is a serene oasis and serves as a sanctuary for individuals recovering from physical or mental challenges, including those with autism and dementia. It is also a restorative outdoor haven where islanders and visitors can engage in prayer, find inspiration, and immerse themselves in the myriad sounds, textures and hues of the natural environment.

The garden and pond attracts birds, butterflies and tadpoles.

Significant sponsorship was received from the Swallow 2018 Charitable Trust to build the Peace Garden.

The garden is a wonderful and special addition to the grounds.



# Day to Day Operations

Our support for charities is not just a policy, it's a mission. We offer discounts to all charities, and each year, two deserving charities are given our facilities free of charge, significantly boosting their fundraising capabilities. Beyond this, we open our doors, offering free or discounted accommodation to charities and individuals in need, a testament to our commitment to tangible support and community solidarity.

The centre is a vibrant hub of activity, hosting an array of weekly events that cater to a wide range of interests. From book and bridge clubs to knitting and chess, Les Cotils is a dynamic gathering place for those seeking engagement, learning, and camaraderie.

Each morning prayers are held, reflecting our unwavering commitment to spiritual growth and support within the local Christian community. Churches are afforded the same discount as charities.

#### Friends of Les Cotils

Their aim is to create a wide circle of friends within Guernsey whilst fundraising for small projects within Les Cotils. It also acts to promote the facilities offered by Les Cotils more widely.

#### Food for Families

Each week during term times we deliver around 1500 pieces of fruit to the junior schools in Guernsey. This initiative started five years ago and is very well received.



Four family fun days were run in the grounds in conjunction with our charitable partners which included face painting, games, bouncy castles and BBQ's.

During the summer holidays the coffee shop opened once a week for families to enjoy a meal and have time together.

- · Weekly food boxes were provided during the summer.
- · A Liberation day party was held.
- · At a Boxing day lunch, over 130 adults and children enjoyed a meal with a visit from Santa.
- · Subsidised meals were delivered to Bright Beginnings.
- · Occasional accommodation was provided for those who have nowhere to go.

## Working with Charities

From time to time, we offer financial support for those who may need white goods or short-term rental support etc.

We also offer support for families and individuals who are going through a particularly difficult time.

We work in partnership with St Peter Port Douzaine to provide more family days.



We offer job opportunities to people who for a variety of reasons cannot get jobs anywhere else. This is outside our normal complement of staff. Support is given through mentoring, training etc.

We help build CVs and confidence to go back into the world of work.

There are up to five positions available through this scheme.

We are also members of the Work to Benefit scheme through the Social Security Department.

In partnership with Les Nicolles, we offer short-term employment to ex-offenders, and, in certain cases permanent roles.

# Community Service Scheme

The Community Service Scheme is run by the Probation Service. As one of their beneficiaries, Les Cotils benefits hugely from the work they do. The team plays a crucial role in maintaining and enhancing our outdoor spaces.



During 2024 the refurbishment of the coffee shop commenced, with a planned opening of July 2025.

A significant part of the new coffee shop will concentrate on the community, although it will continue to operate commercially. It will open early evenings and weekends to allow charities to use it for meetings and get-togethers; it will also offer meals, cream teas etc. for the community.

We are immensely grateful to the Swallow Trust for their support with this project.

We are delighted to reveal that 'Serenity' is coming to Les Cotils, kindly donated by Ken and Linda Acott. This sculpture is one of a limited number created by Simon Gudgeon, one of which is located in Hyde Park, London. This will be a tremendous addition to the grounds of Les Cotils and is a very special gift for the people of Guernsey.





We were thrilled to be part of the very special visit of Their Majesties King Charles III and Queen Camilla to Guernsey in July. It was such a privilege to be part of this wonderful occasion and one of the great highlights of the year.
